The month of December was an exciting time for the staff of Churches United.

In addition to the 23 Tubs of Love that we were able to distribute, there were many anonymous gifts, special gifts from our member churches and individuals, and one very large donation of toys from United Way that arrived after they had already held their gifts for kids event.

The United Way donation allowed us to provide needy parents with a "free" shopping experience during the week prior to Christmas.

There were two donations that really touched hearts. The first was a gift of 15 bags of groceries made by a previous client for the

purpose of creating shelf stable sack lunches for the homeless.

The second was a gift a small mountain of "shoebox care packages" that were made specifically for homeless men, women, and children by a woman who had been distributing them on her own [along with another small mountain of materials to make more].

Our volunteers used the extra groceries from the above donation and from the "giving tree" to make additional sack lunches.

All this generosity led to many a tear of joy from both clients and volunteers.
